- Psychopharmacology is required by the State of California for MFT and LPCC licensure. Psychopharmacology has a prerequisite of Biopsychology (PSYC 306). It is advisable to complete Biopsychology or its equivalent (e.g., Brain & Behavior, Physiological Psychology) prior to entering the M.S. program. Students who have not taken Biopsychology may audit PSYC 306 prior to entering or during the program.
- Students can complete PSYC 461 Psychological Testing and PSYC 465
  Advanced Statistics after admission to the program, although this
  may delay graduation. Because Psychological Testing and Advanced
  Statistics are prerequisites used for classified standing, they must be
  passed with a grade of B- or better.
